

Storehouse West is a food pantry and children's clothes closet that serves individuals and families who

are residents of Sandoval County, New Mexico and meet the federal income guidelines for lowmoderate-income households. Storehouse West can supply registered households with an emergency food package once a month and can assist with water and Waste Management bills once per year
